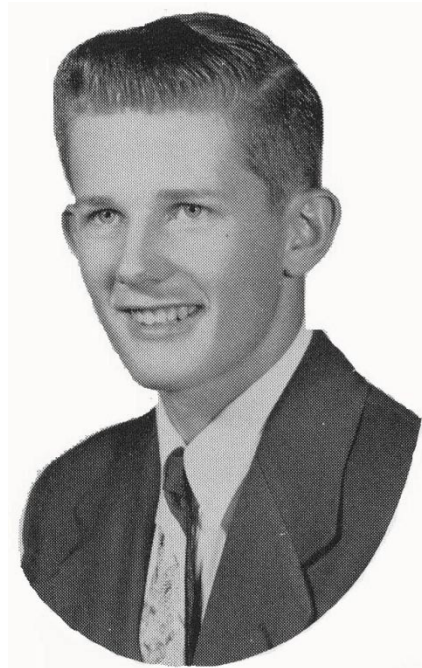

IN THE LAST TEN YEARS
