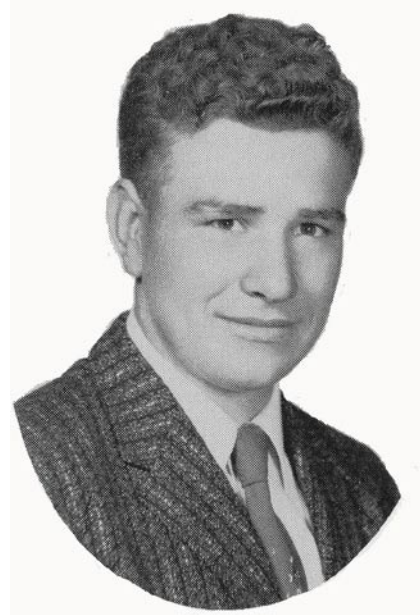

Joe Green was born on June 24, 1941 at Sulphur Springs, Texas. He was the fourth of nine children born to Roger and Ruth Green. The family moved to Grant in 1954. After graduating from PCHS he moved to Denver and in 1965 enlisted in the U.S. Navy. He was then stationed on the U.S.S. Ranger during the Vietnam war where he served as an electrician as well as a fireman's mate. After his discharge in 1969 he remained in California but later moved to Oregon. From there he returned to Grant in 1989 and was associated with P.A.K.S. out of Ogallala working as a residential trainer with mentally disabled adults.

Joe enjoyed bowling and following sports activities of the high school kids. He had been a member of the V.F.W.

He had been in failing health and died at the Grant Hospital, August 20, 1992. He was preceded in death by his mother, and survived by his father, four brothers and four sisters. Services were August 22, 1992 at the Grant Mennonite Brethren Church.
